It Is Necessary To Develop Art-Pedagogical Methods Aimed At The Development Of Students' Personalities. - Defining The Aesthetic Qualities Of Future Professionals;
- Development Of Solutions To The Problem In Research.

The Development Of The Aesthetic Culture Of A Future Primary School Teacher Requires Him To Understand And Feel The Works Of Culture And Art, To Have His Own Aesthetic Position In This Regard. The Essence Of This Can Be Revealed Through The Phenomenon Of Catharsis. Κάθαρσις Means "Ascension, Purification, Healing" In The Ancient Greek Kátharsis, And It Often Means Emotional Upliftment Through Art, Moral Ascension, Liberation From Internal Conflicts, Liberation From Bad Feelings, Deliverance, Purification 3 . It Also Refers To A Process And Outcome That Facilitates, Cleanses, And Has An Appealing Effect On A Person From A Variety Of Factors. In The History Of Aesthetics, Great Emphasis Has Been Placed On The Aesthetic Impact Of Art On Man, Interpreted In A Religious Sense (Purifying The Soul Through Emotional Experiences), Moral (Raising Human Consciousness, Engaging Emotions), Physiological (Relief After Intense Emotional Stress), And Medical.

According To Aristotle, Art Excites A Person, Arouses Compassion And Fear, Sympathizes The Viewer With The Idea Raised In The Play, And Thereby Purifies, Lifts, And Nurtures His Heart. In Other Words, Catharsis Expresses The Essence And Effect Of An Aesthetic Experience That Cleanses The Soul From Various Influences. Aristotle Emphasizes The Educational And Purifying Importance Of Music, Saying That Because Of Music, People Experience "Harmless Joy" And Find Pleasure And Are Cleansed From Bad Influences.

In Psychoanalysis, Catharsis Is Understood As An Individual Or Group Aesthetic Process That Helps Psychodrama, Body-Focused Therapy, Mental Energy Release, Emotional Release, Reduction Of Anxiety, Worry, Frustration, Or Complete Liberation From Them, Self-Awareness⁴. In Freud's Teaching, The Term "Catharsis" Was Used To Refer To One Of The Methods Of Psychotherapy (I.E., Response), Which Leads To Clearing The Psyche From Deep Conflicts And Alleviating The Suffering Of Patients. A Number Of Modern Psychotherapy Techniques And Techniques Are Aimed At Achieving Catharsis.

In 1981, The Screenwriter Of The Film "Catharsis" V. Karev Was The First In Russian And World Literature To Show The Connection Of Catharsis With The Theatrical Drama Of Russian Classicism In

Catharsis Spiritually Cleanses The Motivation Of Future Primary School Teachers To Become Mature Professionals. In This Sense, Catharsis Is Closely Related To Pedagogical Motivation, Demand For Professionalism, Social Order, Content, Value Orientation, And Aesthetic Culture, Which Strengthens Students 'Love For Children And The Pedagogical Profession.

These Are: Motivation; Knowledge; Intellectual And Creative; Practical; Organization Of Activities On The Basis Of The Laws Of Beauty; Understanding Of National Aesthetic Values; Is Self-Improvement Through Catharsis.

As A Result, The Desire To Gain Aesthetic Knowledge And Impressions From The Aesthetic Qualities Inherent In The Personality Of The Future Primary School Teacher; Assessment, Appreciation And Understanding Of Aesthetic Values, Introduction Of Aesthetic Requirements In Daily Life And Professional Activity; Develops Interest In Aesthetic Creative And Pedagogical Activity.
