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Guidelines for Managing Practical Nursing Studies (PN) in Vocational Education Institutions:

Study of Practical Nursing Branch Competency in Thailand and Overseas by Content Analysis.

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This research is an academic document research. And articles both in Thailand and abroad to study the competencies of practical nursing in Thailand and abroad. The scope of this study consisted of competencies in Practical Nursing (PN) of Thailand and abroad as USA, England, Japan, Singapore, and the Philippines. The Data analysis is a content analysis.

From the research, It was found that the Practical Nursing 's competencies consisted of 1) Simple nursing practice, 2) Able to collect recordings. And able to the report information ability, Variable patient information 3) Specific tasks assigned by patients with stable / mild symptoms 4) Supervising the movement and exercise of the patient. 5) Assessment of the patient's condition using simple tools 6) Drug delivery in health care facilities provided by a practitioner or in a place where a person resides independently. Steady or predictable situations of illness. 7) Knowledge in the use of technology and information. 8) Knowledge of morality, ethics and laws and require practical training. Practice in hospital. The qualification is accredited under the Nursing Council of Thailand. While at the School of Practical Nursing (PN) Abroad, the competency of students, Teachers, and educational administration Where registered nurses are teachers. The place of practice is a hospital or nursing home. But there is a difference in the student's educational establishment. In Thailand there are no practical nursing branches (PN) in a technical or technology college in an educational institution in the public sector as well as abroad, for example Singapore Philippines, Japan, Graduates have been awarded a certificate of professional qualification or have a license; The LPN (Licensed Practical Nursing) is tested by the National Council of Nursing (NCLEX-PN). Those who have completed a vocational education institution receive an LVN (Licensed Vocational Nursing) qualification.

1. Introduction

Most countries around the world, including Thailand are facing with the people's health problems due to social, economic, environmental, and medical advances. A technology helping Thai people to prevent the disease and accident. There is a great deal of promotion of self and family health, allowing Thai people to live longer in lifestyle changes. Most of the health problems in the elderly are due to deterioration with age and chronic disease. In this regarding, the Nursing Council that issued individual health care standards was still awareand needed for health care of the population. Such as protection at Health promotion. Caring for the elderly who need a dependency to foster and healthy and health with illness.¹ These elderly people need caregivers such as nurses, Practical Nursing. Including medical personnel in high demand.² There is an education of the need forhealth care in Thailand found that there is a need for human manpower in the next 10 years. There will be a need for people to take care of healthy people in the future.³ The Faculty of Nursing, Ubonratchathani University found that 98.6% had a high demand to produce Practical Nursing⁴. In the present moment, the production of Practical Nursing(PN). Increasing due to demand of the labor market in the health service, the vocational school had less production in the field of Practical Nursing. Most of them are nursing assistant staff (AN).

According to the national strategic plan, there is a policy to increase the rate of vocational education workforce to meet the market and social needs. Educational process for making differentregulatory requirements There must be an analytical study according to the conceptual framework of educational management.⁵ These include 1) learners, 2) educational institutions, 3) teaching and learning, 4) teachers, 5) curriculum, and 6) education administrators. The results of the education management are Vocational education establishments can produce nursing assistant courses to meet market demand. The learners are knowledgeable, capable and have operational skills.⁶

Therefore, the researcher wishes to study the Practical Nursing's competency. (PN) in educational institutions in Thailand and foreign countries that affect the educational management nursing assistant degree in vocational education in Thailand in the future.
